Bill No. 11-169

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Yap State Law No. 11-129, by amending the Title and Section 1 to clarify use of funds and by amending Section 3 to extend the lapse date of funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. The Title of Yap State Law No. 11-129 is
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3 “To appropriate the sum of \$231,239 from the
4 Infrastructure Maintenance Fund (IMF) of the State of Yap
5 for the purpose of providing funding to fund ~~Paved Road~~
6 ~~Maintenance~~government projects during Fiscal Year 20256,
7 and for other purposes.”

8 Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-129 is
9 hereby amended to read as follows:

10 “Section 1. The sum of \$231,239, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
12 Infrastructure Maintenance Fund (IMF) of the State of Yap for
13 the purpose of providing funding to fund ~~Paved Road~~
14 ~~Maintenance~~government projects during Fiscal Year 20256. The
15 sum appropriated shall be apportioned in accordance to the
16 following schedule:

17 (1) Paved Road Maintenance \$ 150,000; and
18 (2) Guardrail Repair/Replacement . . . \$ 81,239.”


1 Section 3. Section 3 of Yap State Law No. 11-129 is
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 3. Allotment and Management of Funds, and
4 Lapse Date. The sums appropriated by this Act shall be
5 allotted to the Governor who shall be responsible
6 for ensuring these funds are used only for the purposes
7 specified under Section 1 of this Act. The sums appropriated
8 by this Act shall be administered in accordance with the
9 provisions of applicable law, including, but not limited to,
10 the State Financial Management Act of 1983 and the State
11 Contracts Act. The authority to obligate the funds
12 appropriated by this Act shall lapse as of September 30,
13 202~~5~~6, and any part of this appropriation not obligated as of
14 September 30, 202~~5~~6 shall revert to the
15 ~~respective~~Infrastructure Maintenance Fund of the State of
16 Yap."

17 Section 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
18 by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such
19 approval.
