Bill No. 11-157

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Yap State Law No. 11-112, by amending the Title and Section 1 thereof to appropriate an additional sum of \$5,743.50 for the SSDI program in the Department of Health Services during Fiscal Year 2026, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1           Section 1. The Title of Yap State Law No. 11-112 is  
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3           “To appropriate the sum of ~~\$43,013,500~~49,657 from the  
4 Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose  
5 of appropriating U.S. Federal grant funds awarded for  
6 public health programs with the Department of Health  
7 Services during Fiscal Year 202~~5~~6, and for other  
8 purposes.”

9           Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-112 is  
10 hereby amended to read as follows:

11           “Section 1. The sum of ~~\$43,013,500~~49,657, or so much  
12 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
13 Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose of  
14 providing funding to fund public health programs with the  
15 Department of Health Services during Fiscal Year 202~~5~~6. The  
16 sum appropriated shall be deemed from United States Federal  
17 Grants awarded for health programs as follow:


18                   (1) FY2025 Yap HIV/AIDS Prevention  
19                   Program..... \$ 21,766;

- 1 (Grant No. 5 NU52PS910242-03-00,  
2 expiring on December 31, 2025)  
3 (2) FY2025 TB Program Program ..... \$ 16,600; and  
4 (Grant No. 5 NU52PS910242-03-00,  
5 expiring on December 31, 2025)  
6 (3) FY2024 Yap State Development  
7 Initiative (SSDI) ..... \$ ~~5,547,501~~11,291.  
8 (Grant No. 5 H18MC00060-32-00/01/02/03,  
9 expiring on November 30, 2025)“

10 Section 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval  
11 by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such  
12 approval.
