

1 Section 2. Conditions and Restrictions.

2 (1) The sum appropriated by this Act shall not be
3 advanced to any agency. Memorandum of agreement (MOA) or
4 other forms of agreement the purpose of which is to obligate
5 and disburse to the agency any amounts from the sum
6 appropriated herein, including reimbursements for payments is
7 prohibited.

8 (2) All funds appropriated by this Act shall be
9 maintained under the authority of the Director of the Office
10 of Administrative Services.

11 Section 3. Allotment and Management of Funds, and
12 Lapse Date.

13 (1) The sum appropriated by this Act shall be
14 allotted to the Governor, or his designee.

15 (2) The Governor shall be responsible for ensuring
16 these funds are used only for the purpose specified under
17 Section 1 of this Act. The sum appropriated by this Act shall
18 be administered in accordance with the provisions of
19 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the State
20 Financial Management Act of 1983 and the State Contracts Act.
21 The authority to obligate the funds appropriated by this Act
22 shall lapse as of September 30, 2025. Any part of the funds
23 appropriated by this Act not obligated by September 30, 2025
24 shall revert to the General Fund of the State of Yap.

1 Section 4. Reports. The Governor shall submit to the
2 Legislature the performance and financial quarterly reports
3 for each of the quarters in each fiscal year no later than
4 twenty days after the end of each quarter. Each quarterly
5 report shall include, but not limited to, complete
6 descriptions of the obligations incurred against the funds
7 appropriated by this Act, and the status of the funds as of
8 the end of the completed quarter.

9 Section 5. This Act shall take effect upon the approval
10 by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such
11 approval.
