

AN ACT

To amend Yap State Law No. 11-92, by amending Sections 1 and 3, for the purpose of extending the lapse date of funds previously appropriated under Yap State Law No. 11-33 for Historical Preservation Office program operation and projects for Fiscal Year 2025 into Fiscal Year 2026, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-92,
2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$7,105.60, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
5 for Historic Preservation Office projects and
6 programs, the remaining balance of funds previously
7 appropriated under Yap State Law No. 11-33, from
8 the Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap during
9 Fiscal Year 2025. The sum appropriated shall be
10 apportioned in accordance to the following
11 schedule:

- 12 (1) FY2022 HPF/Operation \$ 105.60; and
13 (Grant No. P23AF00017-00/01/03, Advice Nos.
14 520Y24030 and 520Y25019)
15 (2) FY2022 HPF/Special Projects \$ 7,000.
16 (Grant No. P23AF00017-00/01/03, Advice Nos.
17 520Y24031 and 520Y2518)"

18 Section 2. Section 3 of Yap State Law No. 11-92 is


1 hereby amended to read as follows:

2 "Section 3. Allotment and Management of Funds, and
3 Lapse Date. The sum appropriated by this Act shall be
4 allotted to the Governor who shall be responsible for
5 ensuring these funds are used only for the purposes
6 specified under Section 1 of this Act. The sum
7 appropriated by this Act shall be administered in
8 accordance with the provisions of applicable law,
9 including, but not limited to, the State Financial
10 Management Act of 1983 and the State Contracts Act. The
11 authority to obligate the funds appropriated by this Act
12 shall lapse as of April 15, 2026, and any part of this
13 appropriation not obligated as of April 15, 2026 shall
14 revert to the Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap."

15 Section 3. This Act shall take effect upon its
16 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law
17 without such approval.
