YAP STATE LAW NO. 11-142

THIRD REGULAR SESSION, 2025

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$78,114.67 from the General Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose of providing funding to fund government project, Stairway from Election Office to Public Park, during Fiscal Year 2026, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. The sum of \$78,114.67, or so much
2 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from
3 the General Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose of
4 providing funding to fund the Concrete Staircase from
5 Election Office to Public Park project during Fiscal Year
6 2026.

7 Section 2. Conditions and Restrictions.

8 (1) Lump-sum budget amounts shall not be
9 advanced to any agency at the beginning of the fiscal
10 year. Memorandum of agreement (MOA) or other forms of
11 agreement the purpose of which is to obligate and
12 disburse to a respective agency its annual budget as
13 approved herein, including reimbursements to such
14 agencies for payments for expenditures under their
15 respective budget, is prohibited.

16 (2) All funds appropriated by this Act shall be
17 maintained under the authority of the Director of the
18 Office of Administrative Services.

1 (3) Funds herein appropriated shall be allotted
2 only on a quarterly basis, except where it is essential
3 for the effective and efficient performance of the duties
4 and responsibilities of an agency to allot certain lump-
5 sum amounts at the beginning of the fiscal year such as
6 for the purchase of fixed assets and for contractual
7 services.

8 Section 3. Allotment and Management of Funds, and
9 Lapse Date.

10 (1) The sum appropriated by this Act shall be
11 allotted to the Governor or his designee.

12 (2) The allottee shall be responsible for
13 ensuring these funds are used only for the purpose
14 specified under Section 1 of this Act. The sum
15 appropriated by this Act shall be administered in
16 accordance with the provisions of applicable law,
17 including, but not limited to, the State Financial
18 Management Act of 1983 and the State Contracts Act. The
19 authority to obligate the funds appropriated by this Act
20 shall lapse as of September 30, 2026, and any part of
21 this appropriation not obligated as of September 30, 2026
22 shall revert to the respective fund.
