

AN ACT

To amend Yap State Law No. 11-112, by amending the Title and Section 1 thereof to appropriate an additional sum of \$5,743.50 for the SSDI program in the Department of Health Services during Fiscal Year 2026, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1           Section 1. The Title of Yap State Law No. 11-112 is  
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3           “To appropriate the sum of \$49,657 from the Special  
4 Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose of  
5 appropriating U.S. Federal grant funds awarded for  
6 public health programs with the Department of  
7 Health Services during Fiscal Year 2026, and for  
8 other purposes.”

9           Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-112 is  
10 hereby amended to read as follows:

11           “Section 1. The sum of \$49,657, or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
13 Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose  
14 of providing funding to fund public health programs with  
15 the Department of Health Services during Fiscal Year  
16 2026. The sum appropriated shall be deemed from United  
17 States Federal Grants awarded for health programs as  
18 follow:

13                   Section 3. This Act shall take effect upon its  
14 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law  
15 without such approval.
