YAP STATE LAW NO. 11-133

THIRD REGULAR SESSION, 2025

AN ACT

To further amend Yap State Law No. 11-112, as amended by Yap State Law No. 11-128, by amending the Title and Section 1 therein to appropriate an additional \$16,602 from the Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the Tuberculosis Prevention Program in the Department of Health Services, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. Title of Yap State Law No. 11-112, as
2 amended by Yap State Law No. 11-128, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 “To appropriate the sum of \$66,259 from the Special
5 Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose of
6 appropriating U.S. Federal grant funds awarded for
7 public health programs with the Department of
8 Health Services during Fiscal Year 2026, and for
9 other purposes.”

10 Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-112,
11 as amended by Yap State Law No. 11-128, is hereby further
12 amended to read as follows:

13 “Section 1. The sum of \$66,259, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
15 Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose
16 of providing funding to fund public health programs with
17 the Department of Health Services during Fiscal Year
18 2026. The sum appropriated shall be deemed from United

1 States Federal Grants awarded for health programs as
2 follow:

3 (1) FY2025 Yap HIV/AIDS Prevention
4 Program..... \$ 21,766;
5 (Grant No. 5 NU52PS910242-03-00,
6 expiring on December 31, 2025)

7 (2) FY2025 TB Program Program \$ 33,202;
8 and
9 (Grant No. 5 NU52PS910242-03-00/
10 6 NU52PS910242-03-01, Advice No.
11 52Y25030, expiring on December 31, 2025)

12 (3) FY2024 Yap State Development
13 Initiative (SSDI) \$ 11,291.
14 (Grant No. 5 H18MC00060-32-00/01/02/03,
15 expiring on November 30, 2025)“

16 Section 3. Conditions and Restrictions.

17 (1) Funds appropriated by this Act shall not be
18 available for obligation for their planned uses by the
19 agency until the respective grant cash amounts have been
20 drawn down by the State and are deposited in their
21 respective State accounts and available for disbursement.

22 (2) The sum appropriated by this Act shall not

1 be advanced to the agency. Memorandum of agreement
2 (MOA) or other forms of agreement the purpose of which is
3 to obligate and disburse to the agency any amounts from
4 the sum appropriated herein, including reimbursements for
5 payments is prohibited.

6 (3) All funds appropriated by this Act shall
7 be maintained under the authority of the Director of the
8 Office of Administrative Services.


9 Section 4. Allotment and Management of Funds, and
10 Lapse Date. The sum appropriated by this Act shall be
11 allotted to the Governor who shall be responsible for
12 ensuring these funds are used only for the purposes
13 specified under Section 1 of this Act. The sum
14 appropriated by this Act shall be administered in
15 accordance with the provisions of applicable law,
16 including, but not limited to, the State Financial
17 Management Act of 1983 and the State Contracts Act. The
18 authority to obligate the funds appropriated by this Act
19 shall lapse as of the respective dates as specified under
20 each grant item under Section 1 of this Act, and any part
21 of this appropriation not obligated as of the date
22 specified for each grant under Section 1 shall revert to

1 the Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap.

2 Section 5. Reports. The Governor shall submit to
3 the Legislature the performance and financial quarterly
4 reports for each quarter in each fiscal year no later
5 than twenty days after the end of each quarter. Each
6 quarterly report shall include, but not limited to,
7 complete descriptions of the obligations incurred against
8 the funds appropriated by this Act, and the status of
9 the funds as of the end of the completed quarter.


10 Section 6. This Act shall take effect upon its
11 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law
12 without such approval.


