

AN ACT

To further amend Yap State Law No. 11-80, as amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-104, 11-107 and 11-118, by further amending Section 2, as amended by Yap State Law No. 11-118, concerning conditions and restrictions of funds, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. Section 2 in Yap State Law No. 11-80 is
2 hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2. Conditions and Restrictions.

4 (1) Funds herein appropriated under U.S.
5 Federal Grants shall not be available for obligation for
6 their planned uses by the respective agencies until the
7 respective grants have been awarded and the respective
8 cash amounts have been drawn down by the State and are
9 deposited in their respective State accounts and available
10 for disbursement.

11 (2) Lump-sum budget amounts shall not be
12 advanced to any agency, with the exception of Yap Visitors
13 Bureau, at the beginning of the fiscal year. Memorandum
14 of agreement (MOA) or other forms of agreement the purpose
15 of which is to obligate and disburse to a respective
16 agency its annual budget as approved herein, including
17 reimbursements to such agencies for payments for
18 expenditures under their respective budget, is prohibited;

1 PROVIDED, however, that appropriated funds for Yap
2 Visitors Bureau shall be granted pursuant to Section 2 of
3 Yap State Law No. 4-81 and Section 2 of Yap State Law No.
4 6-24. All funds appropriated by this Act shall be
5 maintained under the authority of the Director of the
6 Office of Administrative Services, with the exception of
7 Yap Visitors Bureau funds.

8 (3) Funds herein appropriated, with the
9 exception of funds appropriated for Yap Visitors Bureau,
10 shall be allotted only on a quarterly basis, except where
11 it is essential for the effective and efficient
12 performance of the duties and responsibilities of an
13 agency to allot certain lump-sum amounts at the beginning
14 of the fiscal year such as for the purchase of fixed
15 assets and for contractual services.

16 (4) Unless otherwise specified in this Act,
17 funds appropriated herein for personnel shall not be
18 reprogrammed for other uses; except the Legislature
19 specifically approves the following:

20 (a) Election Commissioner's Office
21 may reprogram \$3,000 from Personnel to Fixed Assets.


22 (b) Office of the Governor may
23 reprogram no more than \$25,000 from Personnel for State
24 Funeral expenses.

1 (c) Yap State Legislature may
2 reprogram no more than \$10,000 from Personnel to Travel.”

3 Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon the
4 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without
5 such approval.
