

AN ACT

To further amend Yap State Law No. 11-80, as amended by Yap State Law No. 11-104, by further amending the Title and Section 1 for the purpose of appropriating additional \$11,016 for the Yap State Election Office holding a Special Election during Fiscal Year 2025, by amending Section 2 to authorize reprogramming of funds, by amending Section 3 to provide allottee of funds, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1           Section 1. The Title of Yap State Law No. 11-80, as  
2           amended by Yap State Law No. 11-104, is hereby further  
3           amended to read as follows:

4           “To appropriate the sum of \$10,809,254 from the Yap  
5           State Fiscal Year 2025 financial estimates in Yap  
6           State Treasury for the purpose of funding government  
7           operations, programs and projects in the State of Yap  
8           during Fiscal Year 2025, and for other purposes.”

9           Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-80, as  
10          amended by Yap State Law No. 11-104, is hereby further  
11          amended to read as follows:

12          “Section 1. Operations, Programs and Projects. The  
13          sum of \$10,809,254, or so much thereof as may be  
14          necessary, is hereby appropriated from the State Treasury  
15          for the purpose of funding government operations, programs  
16          and projects during Fiscal Year 2025. The sum

1 appropriated shall be \$10,809,254 from the General Fund of  
2 the State of Yap from Local Revenues for \$9,253,111, from  
3 Program Income for \$739,002, from Airport and Airway  
4 Operation and Maintenance Account for \$125,061, and from  
5 the General Fund Tobacco Tax account for \$692,080; and  
6 shall be apportioned in accordance with the following  
7 schedule:

3                   Section 3. Subsection (4) of Section 2 in Yap State  
4 Law No. 11-80 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5                           "(4) Unless otherwise specified in this Act,  
6 funds appropriated herein for personnel shall not be  
7 reprogrammed for other uses; except the Legislature  
8 specifically approves the following:

9                                   (a) Election Commissioner's Office  
10 may reprogram \$3,000 from Personnel to Fixed Assets."

11                   Section 4. Section 3 of Yap State Law No. 11-80 is  
12 hereby amended to read as follows:

13                           "Section 3. Allotment and Management of Funds, and  
14 Lapse Date.

15                           (1) The sums appropriated and apportioned to  
16 Subsections (1) through (9), (15) through (19) and (21)  
17 through (23) of Section 1 of this Act shall be allotted to  
18 the Governor, or his designee(s).

19                           (2) The sum appropriated and apportioned to  
20 Subsection (10) of Section 1 of this Act shall be allotted  
21 to the Speaker of the Legislature of the State of Yap.

22                           (3) The sum appropriated and apportioned to

1 Subsection (11) of Section 1 of this Act shall be allotted  
2 to the Chief Justice of the State Court of Yap.

3 (4) The sum appropriated and apportioned to  
4 Subsection (12) of Section 1 of this Act shall be allotted  
5 to the Chairman of the Council of Pilung.

6 (5) The sum appropriated and apportioned to  
7 Subsection (13) of Section 1 of this Act shall be allotted  
8 to the Chairman of the Council of Tamol.

9 (6) The sums appropriated and apportioned to  
10 Subsection (14) of Section 1 of this Act shall be allotted  
11 to the State Public Auditor.


12 (7) The sums appropriated and apportioned to  
13 Subsection (20) of Section 1 of this Act shall be  
14 allotted to the State Election Commissioner.

15 (8) All allottees shall be responsible for  
16 ensuring these funds are used only for the purposes  
17 specified in their respective budgets approved by the  
18 Legislature, and that no obligations are incurred in  
19 excess of the respective sums appropriated and apportioned  
20 under the pertinent Subsections of Section 1 of this Act.  
21 The sum appropriated by this Act shall be administered in  
22 accordance with the provisions of applicable law,

1 including, but not limited to, the State Financial  
 2 Management Act of 1983, the State Contracts Act, unless  
 3 otherwise provided by this Act. The authority to obligate  
 4 the funds appropriated by this Act shall lapse as of  
 5 September 30, 2025. Any part of this appropriation not  
 6 obligated as of September 30, 2025, shall revert to the  
 7 respective Fund of the State of Yap."

8 Section 5. This Act shall take effect upon the  
 9 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without  
 10 such approval.
