Dear Mr. Speaker:

Your Committee on Resources, Education and Development, to which was referred Resolution No. 11-138, entitled:

“A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING SUSAN GOOLIYAN TO SERVE AS A MEMBER ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE YAP INVESTMENT TRUST.”,

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of the resolution is expressed in its title.

On December 2, 2025 Governor Francis Itimai transmitted his three nominations for the Yap State Foreign Investment Board. The letter was designated as Governor’s Communication No. 11-490, and on December 11, 2025, Floor Leader Terrence R. Fong, by request, introduced Resolutions Nos. 11-137, 11-138 and 11-139 on October 7, 2024 for Ms. Numie Acker, Ms. Susan Gooliyan and Mr. Bernard Goosur, respectively. The communication and resolutions are assigned to your Committee for consideration.

Your Committee conducted a public hearing on January 28, 2026 at 1:30 pm with the nominee, Ms. Susan Gooliyan, Chief of Commerce and Industry Tony Rutmag and Governor Itimai present, along with Senator Gabriel Ramoloilug present during the hearing.

Governor’s appointment for Ms. Gooliyan to serve on the Board would be a new appointment, and she stated that she will try to do the work and fulfil the responsibilities as she understands them. The FIP Board deals primarily with the review, approval and issuance of Foreign Investment Permits within the legal requirements. Also under the law, they are to look at the economic categories, the regulations and the laws that may not be consistent with the policy of the State or when they feel that such amendments are warranted, they would make appropriate recommendations. The nominee’s background has been in the tourism and in the private business sector.


The nominee also remarked that she feels her previous experience would help her with input into the review and other efforts of the Board.

In looking at the introduced Resolution No. 11-138, your Committee noted its introduction in the last regular session and would make technical amendments to ensure its adoption in the Fourth Regular Session. Further, there is a technical error made in the introduced resolution where the nomination is for the Foreign Investment Board, but the text of the resolution is for Yap Investment Trust. We are offering corrective amendments for this and the appropriated referenced, footnoted communication on the face of the resolution.

3. Title, line 1 - Delete "on the Board" and replace with "the Yap State".
4. Title, line 2 - Delete "Directors of the Yap" and replace with "Foreign"; Delete "Trust" and replace with "Board".
5. Page 1, line 2 - Delete "Third" and replace with "Fourth"; Delete "2025" and replace with "2026".
6. Page 1, line 3 - Delete "on the Board" and replace with "the Yap State".
7. Page 1, line 4 - Delete "Directors of the Yap" and replace with "Foreign"; Delete "Trust" and replace with "Board".
8. Page 1, footnote 1 - delete "491" and replace with "490".

Your Committee, after reviewing the nomination, is in accord with the purpose and intent of Resolution No. 11-138 and recommends its adoption, as amended, in the form attached hereto as Resolution No. 11-138, D1.
