Resolution No.11-142

A RESOLUTION

Approving certain maintenance and repair projects in Yap to be funded under the 3rd Amended Compact Yap's share of Infrastructure Maintenance Fund (IMF).

1 WHEREAS, the Yap State 11th Legislature have reviewed
2 proposals submitted for repair and maintenance of various
3 public projects; and

4 WHEREAS, the Yap State Legislature is aware that the FSM
5 Congress has appropriated Yap's share of IMF through PL 23-121
6 for \$1,614,760.00, PL 24-39 for \$1,614,760.00, and PL 24-01
7 for 1,548,400.00, with the Secretary of the Department of
8 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure (DTC&I) as
9 allottee; and

10 WHEREAS, the total IMF share for Yap appropriated by the
11 FSM Congress is \$4,777,920.00, and was to be deposited into
12 Yap's IMF sub account, and should be sufficient to fund the
13 repair and maintenance proposals approved by the Yap State
14 Legislature; and

15 WHEREAS, the National Government has approved funding
16 under the IMF for certain Yap projects without the Yap State
17 Legislature knowledge and approval; and

18 WHEREAS, the Yap State Legislature is aware of the
19 Compact Fiscal Procedures requirements under Article VII

1 Section 9 of the amended Compact; and

2 WHEREAS, the Yap State Legislature is requesting the
3 Secretary of DTC&I to work with Yap on any future IMF proposed
4 project to comply with Yap State requirements and laws; and

5 WHEREAS the 11th Legislature of the State of Yap received
6 a list of projects from the Administration on October 22,
7 2025, designated as Governor's Communication No. 11-470 and
8 assigned to the Standing Committee on Finance; and

9 WHEREAS after deliberations, the Standing Committee on
10 Finance has reported out recommending that the listed projects
11 be funded from the Yap State allocation for Infrastructure
12 Maintenance Funds from the 3rd Amended Compact as all the
13 projects have met the requirements and qualifications for such
14 funding; now, therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Eleventh Legislature of the State
16 of Yap, Third Regular Session, 2025, that the Legislature
17 hereby approves certain maintenance and repair projects in Yap
18 to be funded under the 3rd Amended Compact Yap's share of
19 Infrastructure Maintenance Fund (IMF); and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the projects listed in
21 Governor's Communication No. 11-470 is herein specified as
22 follows:

- 23 1. Rumuu', Fanif Intersection Road Damaged Culvert

- 1 Pipes (\$15,796)
- 2 2. Gilfith, North Fanif Road Shoulder
- 3 Rehabilitation and Improvement Project
- 4 (\$199,769)
- 5 3. Kaday Paved Road Culvert Rehabilitation &
- 6 Improvement Project (\$83,384)
- 7 4. Amun-Muyub Village Road Culvert Improvement
- 8 Project (\$92,968)
- 9 5. Sea Trans Office Building Roof, Dock Perimeter
- 10 Fence & Security Guard House (\$99,982)
- 11 6. Yap State Election Office Building Improvement
- 12 Project (\$123,208)
- 13 7. Yap Guard Rail, Marking Paint, Vertical Sign &
- 14 Convex Traffic Mirror Installation and
- 15 Maintnance Project (\$227,497.18); and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
17 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
18 States of Micronesia; the Speaker of the Congress of the
19 Federated States of Micronesia; the Secretary of the FSM
20 Department of Transportation, Communication and
21 Infrastructure; the Governor of the State of Yap; the Director
22 of Yap State Office of Planning and Budget; the Director of
23 Yap State Department of Public Works and Transportation; the


1 Attorney General; the Chairman of the Council of Pilung; and
2 the Chairman of the Council of Tamol.

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
