A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Yap State Law No. 11-130, by amending the Title and Section 1, as amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-147 and 11-157, to appropriate the additional sum of \$50,000 from the Yap State Fiscal Year 2026 financial estimates in General Fund for the purpose of providing funding for Yap-United States Military Operation (YUMO) Taskforce during Fiscal Year 2026, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. The Title of Yap State Law No. 11-130, as
2 amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-147 and 11-157, is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 “To appropriate the sum of \$12,000~~110~~,587 from the Yap
5 State Fiscal Year 2026 financial estimates in the General
6 Fund for the purpose of funding government operations,
7 programs and projects in the State of Yap during Fiscal
8 Year 2026, and for other purposes.”

9 Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-130, as
10 amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-147 and 11-157, is hereby
11 amended to read as follows:

12 “Section 1. Operations, Programs and Projects. The sum
13 of \$12,000~~110~~,587, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
14 hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose of
15 funding government operations, programs and projects during

1 Fiscal Year 2026. The sum appropriated shall be from Local
 2 Revenues for \$10,41365,380 from Program Income for \$816,044,
 3 from Airport and Airway Operation and Maintenance Account for
 4 \$129,165, and from the General Fund Tobacco Tax account for
 5 \$700,000; and shall be apportioned in accordance with the
 6 following schedule:


