A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$48,336 from the General Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose of providing supplemental funding to fund Micronesian Legal Services Corporation - Yap Office during Fiscal Year 2026, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. The sum of \$48,336, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
3 the State of Yap for the purpose of providing supplemental
4 funding to fund the Micronesian Legal Services Corporation -
5 Yap Office during Fiscal Year 2026. The funds would be in the
6 form of a grant to the Corporation.

7 Section 2. Conditions and Restrictions.

8 (2) All funds appropriated by this Act shall be
9 maintained under the authority of the Director of the Office
10 of Administrative Services.

11 (3) The Director shall ensure funds are disbursed as
12 a grant in the form prescribed and approved for such purposes.

13 Section 3. Allotment and Management of Funds, and
14 Lapse Date.

15 (1) The sum appropriated by this Act shall be
16 allotted to the Governor, or his designee.

17 (2) The Governor shall be responsible for ensuring
18 these funds are used only for the purpose specified under

1 Section 1 of this Act. The sum appropriated by this Act shall
2 be administered in accordance with the provisions of
3 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the State
4 Financial Management Act of 1983 and the State Contracts Act.
5 The authority to obligate the funds appropriated by this Act
6 shall lapse as of September 30, 2026. Any part of the funds
7 appropriated by this Act not obligated by September 30, 2026
8 shall revert to the General Fund of the State of Yap.

9 Section 4. Reports. The Governor shall submit to the
10 Legislature the performance and financial quarterly reports
11 for each of the quarters in each fiscal year no later than
12 twenty days after the end of each quarter. Each quarterly
13 report shall include, but not limited to, complete
14 descriptions of the obligations incurred against the funds
15 appropriated by this Act, and the status of the funds as of
16 the end of the completed quarter.

17 Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon the approval
18 by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such
19 approval.
