

AN ACT

To further amend Yap State Law No. 11-130, by amending the Title and Section 1, as amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-147 and 11-157, to appropriate the additional sum of \$50,000 from the Yap State Fiscal Year 2026 financial estimates in General Fund for the purpose of providing funding for Yap-United States Military Operation (YUMO) Taskforce during Fiscal Year 2026, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1           Section 1. The Title of Yap State Law No. 11-130,  
2           as amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-147 and 11-157, is  
3           hereby amended to read as follows:

4           “To appropriate the sum of \$12,110,587 from the Yap  
5           State Fiscal Year 2026 financial estimates in the  
6           General Fund for the purpose of funding government  
7           operations, programs and projects in the State of  
8           Yap during Fiscal Year 2026, and for other  
9           purposes.”

10          Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-130,  
11          as amended by Yap State Law Nos. 11-147 and 11-157, is  
12          hereby amended to read as follows:

13          “Section 1. Operations, Programs and Projects. The  
14          sum of \$12,110,587, or so much thereof as may be  
15          necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
16          for the purpose of funding government operations,

1 programs and projects during Fiscal Year 2026. The sum  
2 appropriated shall be from Local Revenues for  
3 \$10,417~~65~~65,380 from Program Income for \$816,044, from  
4 Airport and Airway Operation and Maintenance Account for  
5 \$129,165, and from the General Fund Tobacco Tax account  
6 for \$700,000; and shall be apportioned in accordance with  
7 the following schedule:


