YAP STATE LAW NO. 11-122

THIRD REGULAR SESSION, 2025

AN ACT

To amend Yap State Law No. 11-101, by amending the Title and Section 1 for the purpose of appropriating an additional sum of \$212,926 from the Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap, U.S. Federal grant funds, for the Waab Community Health Center with the Department of Health Services during Fiscal Year 2025, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Yap.

1 Section 1. The Title of Yap State Law No. 11-101 is
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "To appropriate the sum of \$867,704 from the
4 Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the
5 purpose of appropriating U.S. Federal grant funds
6 awarded for a public health program and Waab
7 Community Health Center with the Department of
8 Health Services during Fiscal Year 2025, and for
9 other purposes."

10 Section 2. Section 1 of Yap State Law No. 11-101 is
11 hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 1. The sum of \$867,704, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
14 Special Revenue Fund of the State of Yap for the purpose
15 of providing funding to fund a public health program and
16 Waab Community Health Center with the Department of
17 Health Services during Fiscal Year 2025. The sum
18 appropriated shall be deemed from United States Federal

1 Grants awarded for health programs as follow:

2 (1) Waab Community Health Center

3 Operation Program..... \$ 851,704; and
4 (Grant No. 5 H80CS06653-20-00,
5 expiring on December 31, 2025)

6 (2) FY2025 OPIOD Response (SOR)

7 Program \$ 16,000.

8 (Grant No. 1H79TI087919-01

9 6 NU52PS910242-02-01, expiring on

10 September 30, 2025)"

11 Section 3. This Act shall take effect upon its
12 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law
13 without such approval.

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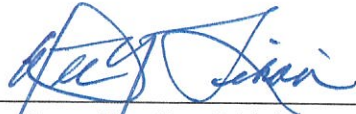
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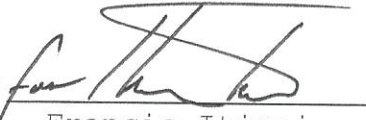
