## A RESOLUTION

Approving certain maintenance and repair projects in Yap to be funded under the 3<sup>rd</sup> Amended Compact Yap's share of Infrastructure Maintenance Fund (IMF).

1           WHEREAS, the Yap State 11<sup>th</sup> Legislature have  
2 reviewed proposals submitted for repair and maintenance  
3 of various public projects; and

4           WHEREAS, the Yap State Legislature is aware that the  
5 FSM Congress has appropriated Yap's share of IMF through  
6 PL 23-121 for \$1,614,760.00, PL 24-39 for \$1,614,760.00,  
7 and PL 24-01 for \$1,548,400.00, with the Secretary of the  
8 Department of Transportation, Communications and  
9 Infrastructure (DTC&I) as allottee; and

10           WHEREAS, the total IMF share for Yap appropriated by  
11 the FSM Congress is \$4,777,920.00, and was to be  
12 deposited into Yap's IMF sub account, and should be  
13 sufficient to fund the repair and maintenance proposals  
14 approved by the Yap State Legislature; and

15           WHEREAS, the National Government has approved  
16 funding under the IMF for certain Yap projects without  
17 the Yap State Legislature knowledge and approval; and

18           WHEREAS, the Yap State Legislature is aware of the  
19 Compact Fiscal Procedures requirements under Article VII  
20 Section 9 of the amended Compact; and

1           WHEREAS, the Yap State Legislature is requesting the  
2           Secretary of DTC&I to work with Yap on any future IMF  
3           proposed project to comply with Yap State requirements  
4           and laws; and

5           WHEREAS the 11<sup>th</sup> Legislature of the State of Yap  
6           received a list of projects from the Administration on  
7           October 22, 2025, designated as Governor's Communication  
8           No. 11-470 and assigned to the Standing Committee on  
9           Finance; and

10           WHEREAS after deliberations, the Standing Committee  
11           on Finance has reported out recommending that the listed  
12           projects be funded from the Yap State allocation for  
13           Infrastructure Maintenance Funds from the 3<sup>rd</sup> Amended  
14           Compact as all the projects have met the requirements and  
15           qualifications for such funding; now, therefore,

16           BE IT RESOLVED by the Eleventh Legislature of the  
17           State of Yap, Third Regular Session, 2025, that the  
18           Legislature hereby approves certain maintenance and  
19           repair projects in Yap to be funded under the 3<sup>rd</sup> Amended  
20           Compact Yap's share of Infrastructure Maintenance Fund  
21           (IMF); and

22           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the projects listed in

1 Governor's Communication No. 11-470 is herein specified  
2 as follows:

- 3 1. Rumuu', Fanif Intersection Road Damaged  
4 Culvert Pipes (\$15,796)
- 5 2. Gilfith, North Fanif Road Shoulder  
6 Rehabilitation and Improvement Project  
7 (\$199,769)
- 8 3. Kaday Paved Road Culvert Rehabilitation &  
9 Improvement Project (\$83,384)
- 10 4. Amun-Muyub Village Road Culvert  
11 Improvement Project (\$92,968)
- 12 5. Sea Trans Office Building Roof, Dock  
13 Perimeter Fence & Security Guard House  
14 (\$99,982)
- 15 6. Yap State Election Office Building  
16 Improvement Project (\$123,208)
- 17 7. Yap Guard Rail, Marking Paint, Vertical  
18 Sign & Convex Traffic Mirror Installation  
19 and Maintenance Project (\$227,497.18); and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
21 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the  
22 Federated States of Micronesia; the Speaker of the

1 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia; the  
2 Secretary of the FSM Department of Transportation,  
3 Communication and Infrastructure; the Governor of the  
4 State of Yap; the Director of Yap State Office of  
5 Planning and Budget; the Director of Yap State Department  
6 of Public Works and Transportation; the Attorney General;  
7 the Chairman of the Council of Pilung; and the Chairman  
8 of the Council of Tamol.
